

Registration Requirements

Your horse must be a registered Purebred Arabian, registered with a Purebred Association. Send a copy of your horses Arabian Registration Certificate.

Your horse must have one or more of the markings of a Sabino horse. You must send photos of the horse showing the markings on each side of the horse (front, back, both sides, and underside of belly or chin if markings occur there). In some cases questionable underlying pink skin must be proven. Also in cases where horse has enough white to be registered as moderate please hold ruler up to white in close-up photos. **Please be aware that two of the submitted photos will be chosen for display on their registration certificate.** Please write your name, the horse's name and AHA# on the back of each photo. Also, your horse will be displayed on our website, you may indicate the photo you wish to have displayed.

Upon registration you will receive a Registration Certificate with your horse's information and photos on it. If a certificate is lost it can be replaced for a fee of \$10 by contacting the SAHR.

Foundation & Mission

This color registry was founded in 2001 by a group of Arabian horse owners and enthusiasts who found Arabians did possess an overo gene, the Sabino gene, that blessed some of them with extensive white markings. The SAHR's mission is to recognize and promote the Sabino traits of the purebred Arabian horse to help them become widely accepted in breeding and the show ring as any other Arabian horse. The Sabino Arabian horse will possess both genes and markings of the pinto color as well as be purebred Arabian upholding correct conformation, Arabian type, and be athletic. Sabino Arabians will be classified into four classes: Minimum, moderate, extreme, and maximum. The Sabino Arabian Horse Registry is strictly a color registry. Thus the Sabino Arabian Horse Registry was born.

Show Payback Program

You must be a member and your horse must be registered with the SAHR to be eligible for this program. Cost is \$40/horse. Forms can be obtained online or by contacting the SAHR. You must send show records to the SAHR for points to be counted. System is based on points awarded taking into consideration number of horses in show and placing. 20% is retained for program costs. Payouts are as follows:

Champion	Trophy & 30%
Reserve	Plaque % 25%
3 rd	15%
4 th	10%

Sabino Markings

Minimum marked (mn):

Any Registered Purebred Arabian horse that has one or more of the following: high white leg markings extending past mid-knee or mid-hock; detached leg markings; a wide blaze, apron blaze, or bald face markings that extend past where the bridle would lay (including chin strap); these and/or white body markings that are not large enough to be registered pinto, with underlying pink skin.

Moderate marked (md):

Any Registered Purebred Arabian horse with enough white to be registered as a Pinto horse and up to 25% body white. To be registered as a Pinto horse: A Pinto horse, without respect to age, must have four (4) square inches of white hair with underlying pink skin.

Extreme marked (ex):

Any Registered Purebred Arabian horse with an extreme amount of body white, over 25% and up to 50% with underlying pink skin. The Extreme expressed Sabino often has splashy white markings and can be a loudly marked overo.

Maximum marked (mx):

Any Registered Purebred Arabian horse with over 50% body white with underlying pink skin. A Maximum expressed horse may be born almost pure white with a medicine hat (dark markings on the ears and forelock) and mottling of color over entire body. Foals born white are not to be confused with the Lethal White foal, which dies at birth or shortly thereafter. A Maximum Sabino foal is born perfectly healthy.
